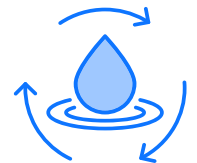

## Water: Data Centers that Consume No Water

While traditional data centers rely on a constant supply of water for cooling, the QTS data center campus will use a closed-loop cooling system that continuously recirculates water rather than drawing from local sources, once operational. This will significantly reduce water consumption and help protect the resources Eagle Mountain depends on.



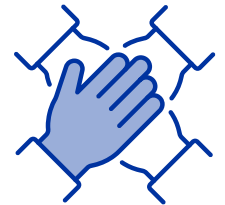
